Course Schedule

Delivery Method

Hybrid - Combined online theory with essential face-to-face training and practical placement experience.

- Students engage in 30-60 hours of self-paced online theoretical learning.
- A minimum of 5 in-person practical sessions is required to complete knowledge and practical assessments plus 1 additional face-to-face training session to complete your manual handling course.

Course Duration

- 3-12 months - practical sessions are scheduled in 2-week blocks each month.



Work Placements

A minimum of 120 hours of work placement, is required for practical experience.



Students have the flexibility to organise their own work placement.

Alternatively, Skills Training College offers support in facilitating work placement opportunities.

Eligibility & Enrolment

There is no academic or previous work experience required to enrol in a Certificate III in Individual Support. However, there are minimum eligibility requirements all students must meet. To be eligible, students must:

- Be at least 16 years old - Any student under the age of 18 must submit a Parental Consent Form before commencing training.
- Have access to a computer or laptop and have a reliable internet connection in order to complete the at-home portion of the course.
- Possess basic proficiency in written and verbal English.
- Possess basic physical fitness to perform manual tasks such as moving patients.
